
Nikkei Seniors Health Care and Housing Society

- At Nikkei Home, what you can do yourself, you are encouraged to do





- Case managed through the Fraser Health Authority


Nikkei Home's Rent and Hospitality Services include

- Accommodation
- Breakfast and evening meals included. (Modified diets will be available to the Resident if prescribed by the Resident's physician as a medical necessity)
- Lunch optional at an additional cost
- Housekeeping at least weekly
- Changing and laundering of linens
- Utilities (excluding telephone and cable television)
- Emergency response system
- Activities programs
- Smoke detectors in suite and common area, fire sprinkler and suppression system
- Fire alarm monitoring
- Kitchen in 1 bedroom suite and Kitchenette in Studio
- Washer/Dryer in 1 bedroom suite and Weekly laundry service for Studios
- Landscaping/snow removal
- Therapeutic Tub Area

Nikkei Home does not provide

- 24 hour professional care
- care for severely confused seniors
- care for difficult behaviour (eg. aggressive residents)

Monthly rent includes rent and hospitality. The fee is on a sliding scale according to income



registered with the Registrar of Assisted Living.

Admittance

If you are not receiving home health services contact your local health authority to express your interest and need for Nikkei Home, ask to be assessed for the Assisted Living Program. If you are already receiving home health services, contact your case manager.

As Nikkei Home is publicly funded, we only admit residents who are referred by Fraser Health Authority.



NEW SAKURA-SO

6677 Southoaks Crescent, Burnaby, BC

NEW SAKURA-SO is a 34 apartment building for independent seniors also located at Nikkei Place.

Opened in 1998, the tenants live in a community adjacent to the Nikkei National Museum and Cultural Centre's programs, and Nikkei Home. They have the comfort of knowing that the management at Nikkei Home can respond to questions, and seniors can take part in the shopping and outing programs, as well as celebrate special occasions together.

Features

One bedroom apartments ranging from 600-700 sf

- kitchen
- · eating area
- washroom
- · living room

The building has two common areas for gatherings, and a communal laundry room.

As an independent seniors apartment, the philosophy is 'seniors helping seniors.' This is demonstrated by seniors volunteering as fire wardens, checking up on one another, offering a helping hand, and being the contact person(s) to open and close the doors by special request of management.

Applying for Tenancy

Rent is on a sliding scale, and seniors apply for tenancy at our office. This project is operated with rental subsidies from HomesBC and generous donations from the community. The waiting list is dependent on the type of unit that becomes available. To qualify, applicants must permanently reside in British Columbia when applying
