



## **STUDENT EMPLOYMENT 2021**

### **Enriched Activity Worker**

(8 weeks, 35 hours per week, starting July 5th, \$15.20/hr.)

#### **Tasks & Responsibilities:**

The Enriched Activity Worker will assist with and develop activities for seniors based on their abilities, interests, language, mobility and cognition. There are 3 focus areas – independent seniors, socially isolated seniors and seniors with cognitive impairment. There are several core programs that the Enriched Activity Worker will work with:

- In-House Programs for assisted living residents
- Programs for residents who need help with their daily activities
- “Iki Iki” dementia-friendly program
- Programs for people in the community to connect, interact and learn together

The Enriched Activity Worker will help to create activities for these programs that are culturally and seasonally relevant and provide useful information for their participants’ daily lives. They will implement and lead these activities under guidance from the Enriched Activity Leader and report to them. These activities will support a more vibrant lifestyle for participants while maintaining COVID-19 prevention measures. The Enriched Activity Worker will learn to work with seniors with different levels of independence to better understand how to conduct activities effectively.

#### **To be eligible, students must:**

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment period;
- have been registered as a full-time student in the previous academic year, and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the [Immigration and Refugee Protection Act](#); and
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

#### **Other criteria:**

- Experience with seniors is an asset
- Fluency in Japanese is an asset
