Student Maintenance Coordinator

(8 weeks, 35 hours per week, starting July 5th, \$15.20/hr.)

Tasks & Responsibilities:

The Student Maintenance Coordinator works with the building Maintenance Team in assisting seniors with home repairs and other maintenance tasks. The successful candidate will work under direct supervision of the Building Maintenance Coordinator. They will learn to use tools, plan/design projects, and work in collaboration with both staff and seniors. This position involves working with seniors, volunteers, other summer student workers. It requires use of tools, working with seniors to interpret their design ideas and receiving and synthesizing feedback on design options.

To be eligible, students must:

- be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment period;
- have been registered as a full-time student in the previous academic year, and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year;
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the [Immigration and Refugee Protection Act](#); and
- be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations.

Other criteria:

- Educational background in trades, building, or experience in maintenance projects or carpentry is an asset
- Experience with seniors is an asset
- Fluency in Japanese is an asset
